2015 Carneros Elizabeth Pinot Noir The Baldacci family purchased the Honey B Vineyard on Cuttings Wharf in Carneros in 2008; it's where they grow the Elizabeth Pinot Noir. The wine is dark and concentrated, with ripe black-cherry flavors checked by pithy pink-grapefruit acidity. It's a warm-cool contrast, lending the wine structure as well as gentle grace. Pour it with beef fillet, seared rare. *Reviewed by Joshua Greene.*
